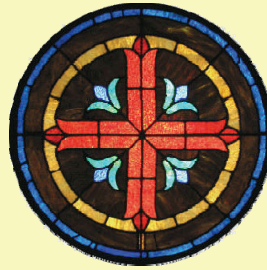

These ministries continue to change lives; not only the lives of the recipients of these ministries, and of their families, but certainly also the lives of the people providing these ministries out of their passion for giving of themselves in the name of Christ.

Peter Nyok is one of the Boys of the Sudan who

lives in San Jose. Last year he formally joined the St. Stephen's parish family. Peter's vision is to provide a safe home for as many Sudanese orphans as he can financially support, and to provide them with an education enabling them to return to the Sudan and make it a healthier, safer, financially viable homeland. This is a vision that extends well beyond providing next week's meals. It requires a long term commitment on the part of sponsors for these children, to ensure that the resources continue to flow that will lead to a stable and revitalized Sudan. We are proud to be a major provider for this effort.

The pre-school we started two years ago had 14 students last year. The devastating financial crisis in Sacramento and the nation has raised the interest in private schools. State budgets are requiring schools to raise the age for children entering kindergarten. This presents additional need for preschool classes. Our school is quickly defining itself as a premier preschool based on Christian values, including chapel services and Bible stories, but also welcoming to all faiths and cultures. This is not simply an academic institution, nor is it just a secular business. It is a ministry to the families of south San Jose. We are extremely proud of the quality of this school, and equally honored to be given the trust and confidence of parents to give their children a firm foundation for their future.

May God richly bless you for your generous support of the work of ministry done through St. Stephen's.
